

Chieftains Continue to Roll

12-1 Over Boscobel

The Riverdale Chieftains won their fourth straight game with a 12-1 win over the Boscobel Bulldogs on Friday night. The Chieftains pounded out 14 hits in the game and received another strong pitching performance from Trevor Troxel to pick up the win. Coach Thompson "I thought we looked good at the plate tonight and our pitching was very strong again."

The Chieftains came out swinging in this one. On a hot afternoon, Bradon Roen got us going with a leadoff walk. Trevor Troxel followed with a long single to right center that would score Bradon and it was 1-0. Trevor Johnson would follow with an RBI single making the score 2-0. Caleb Johnson followed with a pop single to right center to drive in another run. Elijah Cannon slammed one by the short stop to load the bases. Michael Schaefer then ripped an RBI single to right center and it was 4-0. Cody Sperry hit a smash to second to knock in another and we were up 5-0. Coach Thompson "That is the type of start we needed, we came out ready to go."

After a scoreless second we added on four more runs in the third. Elijah got us going with a blast to deep right for a triple. Michael Schaefer promptly delivered an RBI single and it was 6-0. After Cody walked and Ethan Haffner dropped down a great sac bunt, we had runners on second and third. Bradon then whistled a base hit to left to score a pair and it was 8-0. After Trevor T. singled and Trevor J. walked we had the bases loaded. Caleb then drilled an RBI single putting us ahead 9-0.

Meanwhile Boscobel would get their only run of the game in the third. A hit batter and two singles made it 9-1.

In the fourth we added on two more runs. With one out Cody walked and Ethan reached on an error. With two outs Bradon tattooed a shot to left center to drive in a pair and it was 11-1.

We added one more in the fifth. Trevor J. would rip a double down the left field line to get us going. Trevor would score when Elijah smashed a shot off the pitcher to make it 12-1. Coach Thompson "It was nice to hit the ball hard. Hopefully we can carry this into next week."

Meanwhile starter Trevor T. could smell the win and quickly set down the final seven hitters he faced to pick up the win. Coach Thompson "Very nice win for us. Trevor pitched well and the bats are coming around."

The Chieftains are now 11-5 on the season and 7-2 in conference and have two big games next week. Coach Thompson "We are getting better each game. We need to continue to play with intensity, the season is moving quickly and we need to keep our focus as the games grow in importance. "
