The conference baseball season got off to a rough start as the Chieftains lost to Fennimore 12-7 at Fennimore on Tuesday night. In the fourth neither team scored. In the fifth we had a chance to cut deep into the Fennimore lead. With two outs Brett singled to right field, and Trevor Johnson singled sharply to left field. Elijah walked to load the bases. A pass ball had Brett scamper home to make it 8-3 but that would be it in the inning. In the bottom of the frame Fennimore tacked on two runs with two outs to make it 10-3.

We would go out, in order, in the bottom of the sixth and Fennimore again tacked on two more runs with two outs to make it 12-3.

In the seventh we made it interesting. Bradon led things off with a double down the left field line. Jared reached on an error and Brett followed with an RBI single to right, it was 12-4.
