On a great evening for baseball it would be the state's third ranked Chieftains topping the state's second ranked Bulldogs by the score of 7-1 on Friday evening. The Chieftains received a great pitching performance from junior righty Ethan Haffner, who scattered 4- hits and did not allow an earned run, to pick up the complete game victory. Coach Thompson "Great job by Ethan against a real tough team. It was only his second start of the season, he was very sharp out there."

In the much anticipated match up the Bulldogs would strike quickly, taking advantage of two hits and two errors to pick up a run. The Chieftains escaped greater damage on a line drive double play to shortstop Trevor Troxel. We bounced right back in the bottom of the first. With one out Trevor T. walked and stole second. With two outs, Caleb Johnson stepped to the plate and blasted a long RBI double to right center to tie the game.
