### Chieftains Fall to Darlington

The varsity football team opened the 2015 conference season at home against perennial power Darlington and despite playing a pretty good football game lost to the Redbirds by the score of 48-8. The Chieftains were able to move the ball pretty consistently throughout the game but five turnovers would slow the Chieftain attack. Coach Thompson "We did a lot of very good things out there tonight but their size and speed were difficult to handle. With that said we did a very nice job moving the football and if we can clean up some things we are going to become a very dangerous team."

On a very steamy night the Chieftains would start on offense and get off to a quick start, executing the option brilliantly Bradon Roen and Trevor Troxel would rip off runs of thirteen and twelve yards. Unfortunately, on our fifth play Drake Harris would injure his foot and miss the rest of the game. Coach Thompson "Drake has been playing extremely well on both sides of the ball. That really hurt." The Chieftain offense would stall and after a failed fake punt attempt the Redbirds took over. Darlington would strike two plays later on a fifty yard TD run and with the PAT it was 7-0.
