Chieftains Lose to Boscobel 46-34

The varsity football team raced out to a 20-0 first half lead only to see the Boscobel Bulldogs rally in the second half to defeat the Chieftains by the score of 46-34. Coach Thompson "Tough one. We looked so good for most of the first half, but in the second half we just could not get anything going on both sides of the ball."

The Chieftains came out and completely dominated the first quarter of play. On our first drive we went 66-yards on 7-plays to grab the lead. The big play of the drive a 44- yard TD run by Bradon Roen. Coach Thompson "Bradon gave us a huge lift tonight on both sides of the ball, he plays with tremendous determination."

With a 6-0 lead the Chieftain defense would hold the Bulldogs and get a big fourth down stop.
