

Chieftains Host (and Win) Ginger Morrey Invite

The Riverdale track and field teams hosted the annual Ginger Morrey Invitational this past Saturday. Both boys' and girls' teams brought home first place finishes through a number of strong performances.

The girls' team was led by first place finishes by Emily Kuester in the 100 and triple jump, Morgan Watson in the long jump, Shelby Rognholt in the pole vault, Cassie Bradley in the shot put, the 4x100 relay of Kuester, Kennedy Fitzgerald, Becca Pedek, and Ann Hardy, and the 4x400 relay of Kuester, Amanda Pedek, Becca Pedek, and Sarah Pasold. Other medalists included second place finishes by Sam Pedek in the discus and the 4x800 relay of Amanda Pedek, Becca Pedek, Pasold, and Janay Wiedenfeld, and third place finishes by Fitzgerald in the 100 and long jump, Sandra Hanson in the 300 hurdles, Wiedenfeld in the 3200, Amanda Pedek in the 1600, Sarah Pasold in the 800, and Kayla Frazier in the high jump.

On the boys' side, the Chieftains got first place performances from Brett Felton in the 100, Anthony Bart in the pole vault, Zach Pospichal in the long jump, the 4x100 relay of Alex Fiebranz, Nick Wiederholt, Pospichal, and Felton, and the 4x200 relay of Fiebranz, Kyle Peterson, Dylan Peterson, and Anthony Bart. Finishing in second place in their events were Pospichal in the 100 and pole vault, Montana Lins in the 1600, Mitchell Shallwani in the 3200, and the 4x400 relay of Nolan Garoutte, Lins, Wiederholt, and Felton. Rounding out the medalists for the Chieftains were Jacob Nachtigal in the pole vault, Wiederholt in the triple jump, Felton in the long jump, and the 4x800 relay of Garoutte, Lins, Shallwani, and Colten Savage.

The Chieftains will travel this Friday to Boscobel for the annual Sparky Reynolds Invitational before gearing up for the SWAL Championships next Tuesday.
